When St. Mark's opened its food pantry 40 years ago, the goal was simple: feed the hungry. Several members of the church worked with the area's fledgling food bank (which has since become Feeding Southwest Virginia) and began collecting donations in the church entryway. By November 2021, we had launched *The Lion's Share* as a client-choice food pantry, allowing clients to choose the foods they want based on dietary restrictions and preferences. In doing so, we sought to decrease food waste and increase the dignity of our clients by allowing them to make choices rather than handing them a pre-packed bag. We also hope to encourage good eating habits by providing fresh produce, dairy, and other healthier options on a consistent basis.

Our goal today remains the same as it was 40 years ago: feed the hungry. We do this without regard to any other status—all those who need food are welcome at *The Lion's Share*. And we are committed to operating a *community* food pantry—while the pantry is physically located at St. Mark's, we partner with other community organizations for food donations and volunteers, and we welcome clients from all over the Roanoke Valley.

We know that food insecurity is still an issue for many in our community. Feeding Southwest Virginia's "Map the Meal Gap" published in May 2024, shows that 1 in 7 people in Southwest Virginia—and 1 in 6 children—face some level of food insecurity. At *The Lion's Share*, we have fed an average of 400 households representing over 1000 individuals *each month* since the summer of 2023, and we have new neighbors seeking assistance almost every time we open our doors.

In 2023, we held our inaugural *OktoberFeast* event, and thanks to the generosity of our neighbors, we raised over \$20,000 to help feed those in need! Will you help us reach this year's goal of \$25,000 by sponsoring our *OktoberFeast* event on October 25? More details are available in the enclosed brochure.
